'Monistic Structural Realism'

It has been argued that contemporary physics supports Ontic Structural Realism (OSR), and that OSR calls for radical metaphysical revision. I suggest that OSR is best understood as a form of Priority Monism, on which the fundamental ontology is that of the world bearing the intrinsic structural property of having so many parts related thusly. So understood, OSR excises neither objects nor intrinsic properties from fundamental ontology: it instead relocates these to the level of the whole system that has the structure. So understood, OSR calls for a classical metaphysics, albeit not a currently fashionable one.
