## OUTLINE OF A LOCATIONIST THEORY OF PROPERTIES

I start by defending a certain general image of the nature of determinable, determinates and their connection, then I argue that the defended image grounds a particular metaphysics of properties, that I call "locationist nominalism". Finally, I clarify locationist nominalism in some of its main aspects, and defend it against a couple of natural objections.
